

**BY-LAW NUMBER 387-2022 RELATING TO THE REMUNERATION OF ELECTED
MUNICIPAL OFFICERS**

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1

The annual remuneration of elected representatives is established as follows:

Mayor	\$12,485
Councillor	\$4,162

ARTICLE 2

In accordance with section 19 of the *Act respecting the remuneration of elected municipal officers* (RLRQ v. T-11.001), each member of Council shall receive an expense allowance corresponding to half of this remuneration. This allowance is established as follows:

Mayor	\$6,242
Councillor	\$2,081

ARTICLE 3

The remuneration of the members of the council provided for in this by-law is paid every two weeks.

ARTICLE 4

If a councillor occupies his seat for only part of the year, his compensation is determined in proportion to the number of months during which he held that position, and the expense allowance is determined accordingly. Part of a month counts for a full month.

Similarly, if a person who is already a member of Council changes positions during the year, his remuneration is adjusted in proportion to the number of days spent in each position, and the expense allowance is determined accordingly.

ARTICLE 5

The Mayor receives a fixed monthly allowance of \$31.21 to compensate for the use of his cell phone as part of his duties.

ARTICLE 6

The compensation payable to Board members must be indexed annually, as of January 1, based on the consumer price index published by Statistics Canada for the province of Quebec incurred during the previous year.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, a review of the remuneration payable to council members will be made and determined within a period of sixty (60) days following the day of the general municipal elections to be held under the Elections and Referendums Act in the municipalities (L.R.Q. c. E-2.2). The remuneration of the members of the council so determined will be in force and payable to the members of the council as of January 1 following the holding of these elections.

ARTICLE 7

Subject to the authorizations that may be required from the municipal council and the filing of any supporting document attesting to the need for the trip, when a member of

the council must use his motor vehicle to make a trip on behalf of the Municipality, a reimbursement in the amount equivalent to \$0.55 per kilometre travelled is granted.

ARTICLE 8

This By-law takes effect from January 1, 2022, and replaces By-law 375-2021 on the same subject.

ARTICLE 9

This by-law comes into effect according to law.
